The following report (After Action) from 5-3, 317th
Infantry Regiment is submitted in compliance with Section III, 2a
Memo No 64, Headquarters, 80th Infantry Division, dated 24 August 1944.

1 Feb 45 - Regtl CP located at Medernach, Luxembourg; 1st Bn in Medernach, 2nd Bn in Cruchten, 3rd Bn in Heffingen; all troops billeted in houses. Regt conducted training throughout the day, with emphasis being placed on firing of individual weapons.

2 Feb 45 - Regt continued to conduct training. Crew-served weapons were test fired. Flans made for a sniper school.

3 Feb 45 - Regt continued to conduct training. Sniper School conducted for selected personnel of all units.

4 Feb 45 - Regt continued to conduct training: formulated plans for move to Regtl Assembly Area vicinity of Diekirch.

5 Feb 45 - Regt moved to Regtl Assembly Area in .iekirch, closing in at 1530. Issued warning order to units: 80th Inf Biv (Reinf) attacks 0702004 Feb 45, crosses Our & Sauer Rivers, breaches Siegfried Line, and continues attack NE; 317th Inf in Div Reserve present location.

6 Feb 45 - Regt remained in Diekirch. Plans for three possible ways of employing unit issued to Bns. Extensive road reconnaissance made by 8-3.

7 Feb 45 - Regt remained at Diekirch in Div Reserve. 318th & 319th Inf attacked at 0200. Co & 305th Engr (C) Bn conducted a demonstration on the "fuze lighter".

8 Feb 45 - Regt remained in Diekirch. Training was conducted, emphasis on "squad assault teams".

- 9 Feb 45 Regt remained in Diekirch. Training conducted with emphasis on "squad assault teams". At 2100 received instructions to meve Co F to Beaufert, and be attached to 318th Infantry. Co F moved by truck to Begufort.
- 10 Feb 45 Co F moved across Sauer R by boat, took up positions with 318th Inf; remainder 2nd Bn moved to Beaufort prepared to cross with gloth and 3rd Bns remained in Diekirch, continued to conduct training.
- 11 Feb 45 2nd Bn (-) crossed river and were attached to 318th Inf. Remainder of Regt remained in Diekirch, continued to conduct training.
- 12 Feb 45 2nd Bn was relieved of attachment to 318th Infantry and reverted to 317th Inf control; 2nd Bn directed to be prepared to seize high ground S of Rohrbach, and be prepared to continue attack to the high ground N of Rohrbach. 1st Bn moved from Diekirch to Beaufort; 3rd Bn remained in Diekirch. Regtl CP moved from Diekirch to Eullenbach.
- 13 Feb 45 1st Bn remained in assembly area vicinity Beaufort. 2nd Bn maintained positions, sent strong patrols to the N of Rohrbach. 3rd Bn remained in Regtl Reserve in Diekirch, under Division control.
- 14 Feb 45 3rd Bn relieved from Division control, moved to position N of Bollendorf. 2nd Bn seized ground S of Rohrbach. 1st Bn took up positions NW Bollendorf. Regtl Cr remained in Hullenbach.
- 15 Feb 45 Regtl CP moved from Mullenbach to Bollendorf, Germany. 317th Inf (Reinf) ecoupied and impreved defensive positions S Rohrbach.
- 16 Feb 45 317th Inf (Reinf) occupied and improved defensive positions. G Co seized Schwarzen, capturing 53 FW's. Co I occupied Hill 386.
- 17 Feb 45 Regtl CP remained in Bollendorf. Co G repulsed enemy Counterattack consisting of 4 enemy tanks. Reinforced Flat from Co E took 4 houses in Rehrbach.
- 18 Feb 45 317th Inf (Reinf) seized and occupied Rehrbach and Stockigt. No other changes.
- 19 Feb 45 Regtl CP moved from Bellenderf to Schwarzenbruch. Regt continued attack NE. 2nd Bn seized Freilingerhohe and Nusbaum and Preilingen. 3rd Bn cleared woods S of Enzen. 1st Bn remained in Regtl reserve.
- 20 Feb 45 317th Inf (Reinf) continued attack to NE. 1st Bn located in Enzen. 2nd Bn seized Hill 407. 3rd Bn seized Bridge scross Lnz River in vicinity Lnzen, crossed river and seized enzen.

21 Feb 45 - Regtl CP moved from Schwarzenbruch to Nusbaum. 1st En advanced approx 1000 yds against heavy resistance. 2nd En continued mepping-up operations vicinity Mill 407. 3rd 3n attacked to NE against heavy resistance, advanced to ground Sw Steffershof.

22 Feb 45 - Under cover of darkness 1st Bn 317th Inf was relieved by elements 5th Inf Div; 1st Bn assembled in vicinity Musbaum. 2nd Bn moved CF to Feilinger. 3rd in maintained contact with 5th Inf Div on the right; 3rd Bn CF at Enzen.

23 Feb 45 - Regtl CP remained in Nusbaum. 1st En vicinity Nusbaum in Regtl reserve, prepared to relieve elements 318th Inf. 2nd & 3rd Ens 317th Inf centinued to improve and occupy defensive resitions.

24 Feb 45 - 1st Bn 317th Inf relieved A & B Cos of 318th Inf vicinity Mettenderf. F Co with two squads G Co centinued to occupy positions hill 407. 3rd En continued to occupy position No of Enzen.

25 Feb 45 - Regtl Cr moved from Nusbaum to Mettenderf at 1800. 317th Inf cleared mettenderf, Niehl, Claderf and Hisell of enemy.

26 Feb 45 - Regtl Cr moved from Mettendorf to Feilsdorf. 1st Bn seized and occupied Hill 380; counterattackrepulsed by Co Ai, 8 m's taken. 2nd Bn moved to assembly area at missmannsdorf. 317th Inf occupied ground vicinity Koosbusch. Co A 702nd Tk in relieved of attachment 317th Inf effective 261515A.

27 Feb 45 - 1st Bn 317th Inf centinued to improve and occupy
Hill 380; sent daylight patrels to Liessem, found town occupied by
enemy. 2nd Bn in assemly area vicinity dissmannsdorf, outposted high
ground vicinity town with three reinf plats; remainder of an billeted
in town. 3rd in centinued to occupy and improve position vicinity of
Keesbusch.

28 Feb 45 - Regtl Cr meved from Feilsdorf to Biersdorf. 517th Inf attacked night 28 Feb - 1 Mar, seized high ground w Schleid. 1st En seized high ground w Schleid. 1st En Biesdorf, Frum River. 2nd En seized high ground w Scheid. 5rd en assemled in Regtl reserve in area Wiersdorf, Miersdorf, Missem.

the German Army. The resistance was not determined in the sense that the German seldier resisted to the end; after a short fight, the Germans would, in most cases, surrender.

Further evidence of the collapse of German resistance was the appearance of numerous battle groups, composed of the remnants of several divisions. Considerable amounts of material were captured, including at least nine cannons in excellent shape and several tanks. This equipment, according to IW's was abandoned because of lack of gaseline.
