## Time sequence of action at HAN sur NTED

- 1. Units of 317th spent the night in vicinity of LUPPY.
- 2. Left LUPPY 0800 11 Nov 1944.
- 3. Arrived BECHY 1030 11 Nov 1944.
- 4. Formed with units of the 6th Armd Div and pushed off at 1100 11 Nov 1944.
- 5. At 1145 enemy vehicles left woods going toward HAN sur NIED. Lt Col Hines and Lt Col Burnett went to the edge of the woods.
- 6. 1210 enemy tanks moved out of HAN sur NIED toward VATIMONT.
- 7. 1210 TDs took tanks under fire.
- 8. 1215 Lt Yetman called for fire on VATIMONT.
- 9. 1230 Concentration placed on VATIMONT.
- 10. 1230 Time fire on HAN sur NIED by the 6th Armd forward observer.
- 11. 1240 Cel Hines ordered infantry CO forward with 5 tanks.
- 12. 1250 Column pinned down by enemy fire from high ground behind HAN sur NIED.
- 13. 1320 Capt Craig, now Major, urged his men toward the bridge.
- 14. 1345 Capt Craig<sup>1</sup>/s men reached the bridge--3 tanks on the bridge.
- 15. 1400 Got across the bridge to the first house.
- 16. 1415 Moved to second house down the road.
- 17. 1445 Capt Craig got tanks off bridge and up into firing position behind houses.
- 18. 1500 Eight Germans ran from trench and were killed by tank MG.
- 19. 1500 to 1700 troops in town and behind the railroad embankment had fire fight with the enemy.
- 20. 1715 Col Hines crossed the bridge with 15 men and contacted Capt Craig.
- 21. 1730 Companies C and B crossed the bridge.
- 22. 1800 Capt Craig organized the Bn for the defense of the town.
- 23. 1800 Capt Brown crossed bridge with eight medium tanks.
- 24. 1810 Capt Smith crossed with seven light tanks.
- 25. 1820 An armored infantry crossed the bridge.
- 26. 1830 Companies B and C cleared the town.
- 27. 1845 Organized defense of the town.
- 28. 1930 German motorcycle was hit, one occupant killed, the other got away.
