BATTLE PARTICIPATION AWARDS - GERMANY CAMPAIGN (NO. 1)

1. The following extract of Letter Headquarters European Theater of Operations, U. S. Army, 24 December 1944, File AG 200.6 OpGA, subject as above, is quoted for the information and guidance of all concerned:

"1. In accordance with the provisions of paragraph 12 b (2), AR 260-10, C13, 1 November 1943, announcement is made of units awarded battle credit for participation in the campaign "Germany", as established by paragraph 3, Section VI, General Orders 80, War Department, 5 October 1944:

2. Attention is invited to paragraph 7b, Section I, Circular 195, War Department, 18 May 1944, regarding eligibility of individuals to wear a bronze service star on the theater ribbon.

3. In compliance with paragraph 8, Circular 62, War Department, 11 February 1944, necessary entries will be made on service records (WD AGO Form No. 24) of enlisted personnel, and on qualification cards (WD AGO Form No. 66-1) of officers and warrant officers, whose eligibility to wear a bronze service star on the theater ribbon is established."

4. Battle participation credit for Northern France has been requested by this Headquarters. When received, notification will be given to organizations concerned.
