I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL (OAK LEAF CLUSTER): By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, in addition to the Bronze Star Medal previously awarded, a bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded the following named personnel for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States:

ELMORE C. KERR, JR, 0454361, Major, General Staff Corps, Headquarters 80th Infantry Division, United States Army. For the period 24 January 1945, to 7 May 1945, in LUXEMBOURG, GERMANY, and AUSTRIA. Entered military service from NEW YORK.

II. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR MEDAL: By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded the following named personnel for meritorious service in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States:

REX L. PRUETT, 0535235, 1st Lt, Infantry, Headquarters 80th Infantry Division, United States Army. For the period 15 October 1944, to 7 May 1945, in FRANCE, LUXEMBOURG, GERMANY, and AUSTRIA. Entered military service from KANSAS.

III. AWARD OF MERITORIOUS SERVICE UNIT PLAQUE:

Under the provisions of Circular 345, War Department, dated 23 August 1944, the Service Company, 317th Infantry, 80th Infantry Division, is awarded the Meritorious Service Unit Plaque for superior performance of duty, achievement, and maintenance of a high standard of discipline during the period 6 August 1944, to 8 May 1945.

IV. AWARD OF PURPLE HEART (OAK LEAF CLUSTER): By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, in addition to the Purple Heart and bronze Oak Leaf Cluster previously awarded, a second bronze Oak Leaf Cluster is awarded Pfc Paul E. Fought, 36727642, MD, for wounds received as a result of enemy action in Luxembourg on 27 January 1945.

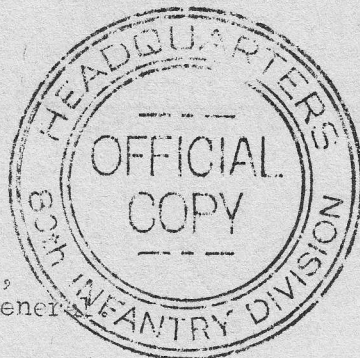
