About 1630 enemy mortar shells started falling in the vicinity one EM killed and 2 EM wounded, one EM stepped on an S-mine wounding himself & one other EM. Removed 10 Piegal mines & also removed an abatis consisting of 15 trees and 6 tangle vines.

At 1800, 3 Oct 44 the 1st squad of the 2nd platoon moved out with F & G Cos of the 318th Inf to take Manoncourt. About one mile south of town Sgt Jackson, the squad leader was wounded by rifle fire at 1830. pfc Gerlach, acting squad leader continued on mission. After Manoncourt was taken, squad moved out with F Co and put in a road block while under enemy fire. Road block consisted of 8 trees felled across the road SW of Manoncourt. 2nd squad of the 2nd platoon repaired a by pass NW of Belleau, France. 3rd squad of 2nd platoon removed 9 tailer mines & 5 reigal mines on road North of Belleau, also removed an abatis, consisting of 3 trees felled across the road. The 3rd platoon's mission was to follow the 318th inf until they had obtained their mission objective and to remove mines, booby traps & road blocks, which would retard their advance.

3rd squad of the 3rd platoon moved out with Co #1 of the 318th with the mission to remove mines along route. During the night move the squad was caught in enemy mortar fire killing one EM, seriously wounding one and slightly wounding two.			
All casualties occurred in France.
