Upon arrival Co. F went into position 2 1/2 miles NW at town of Heiderschied-ergrund, Luxembourg (72.7-46.5) with mission to protect the bridge and establish Road Blocks at that place. Anti-Tank platoon attached to Co. F. Co's E, G & H occupying positions in town of Heiderschied to provide local security at that point.
