Arrived at that town at approximately 1925 30 Apr 45 without incident. Distance traveled: 25 miles. Upon arrival, Bn (less Co. E & Anti-Tank platoon) was billeted in this village. Local security was immediately posted. Anti-Tank guns took up positions along roads offering any possible enemy infiltration. Co. E continued via motor to take up positions in village of Holl Gobin, Germany. At 2400 Bn awaited further orders. At approximately 1215 1 May 45 Bn received orders to continue to town of Dingolfing, Germany. Departing at approximately 1230 Bn

Bn crossed Inn River into Bernau, Austria at 1330 continuing its drive SE with no resistance until in the vicinity of Timelkam, Austria where resistance consisted of small arms, automatic weapons and sniper fire. Being delayed at that point for approximately 3/4 hour. Bn continued drive to Timelkam. Arrived at Timelkam at 2130. Distance traveled 104 miles. Local security posted and patrols are active. 


