31 Aug 44—En route to Bn objective at Map Coordinate "C" Map 15 G 1:100,000. Departed from NE of Chalbn-Sur-Marno (58.0-45.8 12 F4 1:50.000) at 0930 via motor. Detrucked at 1230. Distance 24 miles. Bn then started by foot for its objective at Meerin ("J" Map 15G 1:100.000) At 2400 Bn still on route. Weather: Rain in morning, warm in afternoon.

1 Sept 44—Meerin, France ("C" 15 G 1:100.000) Arrived at Reimont ("J" 15 G 1:100.000) at 0130 after a march of 26 miles. Went into temporary bivouac. Departed at 0930 and arrived at objective at 1900. Distance by foot 14 miles. No enemy encountered. Weather: Warm.

Sep 5-8 '44 - Bn OP at Montauville (RR 74.8-44.8 Map 140 1:100,000) at 0240 on 7 Sep 44. Bn departed Thlaucourt at 0400 to cross canal and Moselle River at Vandieres (RR 75.9-51.0 Map 140 1:100,000) Heavy artillery and AA and heavy weapons fire encountered on morning of 7 Sep 44. Canal was crossed early in morning of 8 Sep 44, but heavy enemy fire prevented the river crossing. Many casualties resulted. Bn began drawing over canal at approximately 1600 on 8 Sep 44 and infiltrating to assembly area at RR 70.0-51.3 Map 140. Troops entrucked at approximately 2400 for departure to above OP on Hill 350. Co. 7 still in position at Vandieres. (RR 75.9-51.0 Map 140 1:100,000) Bn attempted crossing at Pagny-Sur-Moselle on 8 Sep 44. The situation of Co. 8

crossed canal but not river. Were forced to withdraw under heavy fire from artillery, mortars, and machine guns. At second attempted crossing at Vandierga, Co's F & G crossed canal but not river. Dug in and held positions during day, but withdrew at dark. Co. F remained in position to hold bridgehead.

7 Sep 44 - Bn CP at Montauville (RM 74, 844.8 map 1:50,000) at 1600. Arrived by motor at approximately 2230. Distance 25 miles. Bn in temporary positions behind Hill 350. Bn ammunition train upon entering CP was hit afire by explosion of hand grenade and entire basic load was destroyed, along with one communication jeep and trailer. One (1) serious and three (3) slight casualties resulted. Weather: Cool with intermittent rains.

Bn departed from assembly area, vicinity of Forest De Culte at approximately 0400 12 Sept 44 to cross canal and Moselle River and to proceed to seize and hold Bn objective on Hill 350. Crossing made at approximately 0430 by boats and foot bridge. Objective reached and occupied at approximately 0800. Artillery and heavy weapons fire encountered all the way and many casualties were suffered. On gaining its objective the Bn showed fine spirit and dash and never once faltered en route.
