 CP attacked to the west from east of the Moselle river. Mission to take Pont-a-Mousson and then seize and hold high ground west of town.  
 1st and 2nd Bns attacked at 0900 hour with 3rd Bn in reserve. Both attacking Bns pinned down east of Moselle by heavy arty fire. 3rd Bn ordered to attack abreast of 1st and 2nd Bns late in afternoon. Also held up east of Moselle by determined enemy resistance. At time of this report east of Moselle river with 3rd Bn having advanced to outskirts of Pont-a-Mousson preparing to cross river under cover of darkness using Pontoon Bridges and assault boats. Heavy casualties suffered as result of enemy action.

OT attempted crossing of Moselle River at three points. 1st Bn north of Pont-a-Mousson, 2nd Bn south of Pont-a-Mousson and 3rd Bn at Pont-a-Mousson. All three attempts were repulsed by enemy. 3rd Bn established bridgehead with L Co affecting the crossing and holding bridgehead. Enemy counterattacked this bridgehead at dawn wiping it out. Co L suffered 110 casualties Co I suffered 50 casualties as a result of this action. All of the Bns under severe arty fire during day. Other attempts to cross during the day were repulsed. At time of this report OT is reorganizing. 1st and 3rd Bns remaining close to river and 2nd Bn withdrawn to high ground.

OT attacked 0400 hour across Moselle river to the east, behind a 25-minute barrage. Mission of OT-to occupy high ground East of Dieulouard and prepare to resist counter attacks within zone of advance. OT crossed Moselle river under enemy arty, MG, and mortar fire with 2nd Bn leading and 1st Bn close behind. 2nd Bn swung to N and attacked high ground on left flank of OT sector, 1st Bn attacked high ground straight to the front in center of OT sector. 3rd Bn crossed simultaneously with 1st & 2nd Bns and at a point south of 1st and 2nd crossing. Attacked high ground on right flank of OT sector. By 0730 hour all Bns reached objectives. Bns remained on objectives. Intense enemy arty fire falling on positions throughout period.

OP located 80.9-29.3 Maps France 1:100,000 Sheet 14 & Vicinity Bezaumont. At 0400 hr enemy counterattacked in 2nd Bn sector. Companies F & G were forced back but re-organized and threw back the enemy attack. At approx 1000 enemy again attacked with armor & infantry in the 2nd Bn sector. This attack was repulsed with the aid of 702 Tank Bn, resulting in heavy losses of armor to the enemy. Enemy then settled down to heavy shelling of all positions. Many attempts were made by the enemy to knock out bridge across the Moselle river without success. By late afternoon COA had crossed in force thus neutralizing the danger of a massed attack with armor by enemy. 3rd Bn under extremely heavy arty fire on high ground vicinity of Falise at 1700. This fire neutralized by Div arty. OP crossed Moselle river at 1400 hour. OP in constant contact with with enemy throughout period.
