1. Technical inspection of guns of 702nd Tank Battalion by 129th Ordnance (MM) Company was completed on 7 November 1944.
2. Result of inspection of unit maintenance;
 - a. 1st echelon maintenance; No deficiencies noted. Rating: Excellent.
 - b. 2nd echelon maintenance; No deficiencies noted. Rating: Excellent.
3. Guns were winterized by application of correct ordnance greases in accordance with current Ordnance Lubrication Guides and Technical Bulletins.
4. Inspection revealed that gun books are improperly kept and on some guns no books were available. Gun books are provided for keeping essential data. If books are not available, information must be kept in improvised books.
