- 3. In compliance with paragraph 8, Circular 62, War Department, 11 Feb 1944, Circular 111; Headquarters European Theater of Operations, U. S. Army, 15 November 1944, as amended by Circular 30, 22 March 1945, and letter, Headquarters European Theater of Operations, U. S. Army, file AG 200.6 OpGA, subject: "Individuals Entitled to Battle Participation Credit", 28 April 1945, necessary entries will be made on page 6, "Medals, Decorations, and Citations" in service records of enlisted personnel and in Item 31 on qualification cards of officers, whose eligibility to wear a bronze service star on the theater ribbon is established.
