I. AWARD OF BRONZE STAR, POSTHUMOUSLY: By direction of the President, under the provisions of Army Regulations 600-45, dated 22 September 1943, as amended, the Bronze Star Medal is awarded, posthumously, to the following named Enlisted Men:

Wilfred J. Dubois, 6294319, Pvt, FA, Army of the United States. For heroic service in France during the period 12 - 18 September 1944, in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. During the period 12 - 18 September 1944, Pvt Dubois repeatedly and without regard for his own safety, exposed himself to enemy fire to service and relay communication lines which had been disrupted by continuous enemy shelling and mortar fire. It was while he was performing such duties as field wireman that Pvt Dubois lost his life. His personal bravery, determination, and zealous devotion to duty exemplify the highest traditions of the armed forces of the United States. Entered military service from Oklahoma.

William J. Rennich, 33282387, Tec 5, FA, Army of the United States. For heroic service in France during the period 12 - 17 September 1944, in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. During the period 12 - 17 September 1944, Tec 5 Rennich repeatedly and without regard for his own safety exposed himself to enemy fire to service and relay. communication lines which had been disrupted by continuous enemy shelling and mortar fire. It was while he was performing such duties as field wire chief that Tec 5 Rennich lost his life. His personal bravery, determination, and zealous devotion to duty exemplify the highest traditions of the armed forces of the United States. Entered military service from Pennsylvania.

Stanley C. Stankiewicz, 35330927, Pfc, FA, Army of the United States. For meritorious service in France during the period 4 September 1944, to 4 November 1944, in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered military service from Indiana.

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wounded comrades. The outstanding courage, initiative, and constant devotion to duty displayed by Pvt Henson exemplify the highest traditions of the armed forces of the United States. Entered military service from Alabama.

Frank J. Krenek, 32240267, M Sgt, Inf, Army of the United States. For meritorious service in France during the period 6 August 1944, to 24 November 1944, in connection with military operations against an enemy of the United States. Entered military service from New Jersey.

Lt McConnico has consistently distinguished himself in the performance of his duties as tank platoon leader. The courage, efficiency, leadership, and sincere devotion to duty displayed by Lt McConnico exemplify the finest traditions of the armed forces of the United States. Entered military service from Texas.
