One German prisoner was killed by mortar fire as he was being taken back to our lines. In another group Pfc Panisai was taking in four prisoners when a mortar shell hit close by, wounding him and two of the prisoners. The two wounded prisoners helped Panisai to be carried in and on the way, three more prisoners were picked up. Enemy morale was high but our's was higher. Visibility was almost nil but mission was

RECORD OF EVENTS

The 3rd platoon and 1 squad of the 1st platoon pushed off this morning to force a bridgehead over the Seille River. South of Neufmarche, engineer unit was the infantry unit responsible. A 120mm mortar was used to support bridge, 72 foot long, and in two hours had the infantry vehicles across the river. They were hindered by the swollen river and the engineers had to carry all the equipment by hand to the bridge site. The 1st squad of the 1st platoon was to blow the piers of a blown bridge to make a tank crossing. The piers were blown but the water was still too deep for the tanks. No casualties in this working unit although they were under enemy observation and fire by mortars and artillery. The infantry moved swiftly which was a great asset to the mission. Enemy morale was good, but ours was very high.

Last night the 1st & 3rd platoons, under cover of darkness, unloaded all the equipment from the trucks so as to start the construction of the bridge as soon as possible. The bridge started to go up at about 1100 hours this morning. Work was going along good according to reports up to 1200. No further reports. Lt Miller & 3 KM in a jeep were riding along the highway from Chemy to Landroff going South, when their jeep collided head on with another jeep. Officer was sent to the hospital but the other 3 KM were not seriously hurt, just shaken up. Lt Miller's platoon had been clearing roads of mines all day and it was on his last trip coming in that the accident occurred.
