  - e. Original cadre transferred from 8th Infantry Division, balance of enlisted men received through draft, with a small proportion of voluntary enlistments.

2. Principal changes in organization resulted from changes in Tables of Organization, and the activation of a Cannon Company about the month of November 1942, and reactivation in September 1943.

5. All marches were accomplished in the drive towards Germany. CT elements in contact with or in pursuit of the enemy during the course of all marches.

- 1 Sep 44 to 2 Sep 44: Vicinity of Ft. De Liouville, France to vicinity of Apremont, France. Approximate distance, 5 miles, roads good.

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23 September 1944

CT ordered to attack at 1600 to the East and seize Hill 401 and Hill 418. Attack jumped off at 1645, 3d Bn leading, followed by 2d Bn. Very little progress made. 1st Bn continued to engage enemy in Bois de la Rumont and protected flank of Regiment.

24 September 1944

Attack renewed by 3d Bn at 0700. By 1000 3d Bn had reached objective. 2d Bn reached objective (Hill 418) 1200. 1st Bn ordered to relieve elements 318th Inf on Hill 340.

25 September 1944

3d Bn ordered to follow 318th in attack on St Jean. 2d Bn ordered to attack Moivrons in conjunction with CCB, 6th Arm'd Div at 0900 26 Sept. 1st Bn continued to hold Hill 340. 3d Bn ordered to attack Mt St Jean.

26 September 1944

2d Bn attacked Moivrons at 0900 in conjunction with CCB, 6th Arm'd Div. Attack was repulsed and Bn withdrew to Hill 418. 3d Bn withdrew to high ground South of Mt St Jean. 1st Bn continued to hold Hill 340.

27 September 1944

Enemy counterattacked 1st Bn on Hill 340 at 0100 and were repulsed with heavy losses. 2d Bn held position on Hill 418. 3d Bn continued to hold position. Active patrolling conducted by all units. CT ordered to organize defensive positions on high ground South of line Morey-Bratte-Villers les Moivrons. 3d Bn on right, 1st Bn on left, 2d Bn in reserve, N of Montenoy.

28 September 1944

CT continued organization of defensive position. Enemy counterattacked 1st Bn on Hill 340. Attack was repulsed.

29 September 1944

CT continued organization of defensive position.

30 September 1944

CT continued organization of defensive position.

19 September 1944

Small enemy delaying forces operated ineffectively in the ECIS DE CHAPITRE.

20 September 1944

An enemy force of about 100 men, with two 75mm AT guns and 5 HMG's held Hill 299 South of MILLERY. B Company's attack with tanks at 1700 captured forty-six PW's, and the remainder either scattered or were killed. The remnants of the enemy delaying detachments, estimated as 120 men, established a road block at 85352499, interfering with the flow of supplies to our 2d and 3d Battalions. This force had the support of 150mm guns and 120mm mortars, with a radio for fire direction.

21 September-22 September 1944

The enemy line to our front extended from hill 401 through BRATTE. The German road block at 85352499 continued to harass our supply, and resisted the attempts of the 1st Battalion to dislodge them.

23 September-25 September 1944

The Germans at the road block at 85352499 were either killed, captured or withdrew during the night of the 23d September. Our 2d and 3d Battalions, attacking at 1630, were held up by enemy delaying forces, heavily armed with LMG's, on Hill 401. The delaying forces were either killed or captured, or withdrew to positions on MT ST JEAN-MOIVRONS, early on the 24th September.

26 September 1944

An enemy force estimated at 1 battalion defended the Northwest part of MT ST JEAN, with the support of 120mm and 80mm mortars, 150mm gun, and direct fire artillery from JEANDELINCOURT, MOIVRONS and MT ST JEAN, and were able to maintain their positions. The 1st Battalion of the 3d Paratroop Training Regiment, from well organized positions around MOIVRONS, supported by medium and light artillery and mortars, successfully defended against our attack. An enemy force estimated at 1 company were forced to withdraw from Hill 340 by the 1st Battalion, and occupied SERRIERES, SIVRY, MT ST JEAN (NW) and MOIVRONS.

27 September 1944

The Germans, preceded by heavy artillery and mortar fire, attacked Hill 340 with CT 13 (XII) and CT Hildebrand, a total strength of 200-250 men. The German attacking force came from SIVRY and SERRIERES, moved around the base of Hill 340, and attacked from the North and Southwest. These German forces suffered extremely heavy casualties, and the remnants were forced to withdraw. This force penetrated some of our forward positions and approached the C Company CP to within 15 feet, where they were killed or wounded by point blank pistol, machine-gun and rifle fire, as well as grenades.


28 September 1944

In the morning at about 0630 German remnants of about 120 men again attacked Hill 340, using tactics similar to those used on the attack the

night of the 26th-27th September. In spite of a strong artillery concentration fired to precede the attack, the Germans were unable to get close enough to our Infantry to be effective. They again suffered heavy casualties, and were demoralized by artillery concentrations fired by our Cannon Company.

29 September-30 September 1944

The enemy occupied MT ST JEAN, SIVRY, SERRIERES and MOIVRONS, and were active with 120mm and 80mm mortars and light artillery fire.

REPORT FOR HISTORY SEPTEMBER 1944 - S - 2

1 September 1944

1) Enemy.

There was no enemy contacted other than small delaying forces, and their attempts at delay were ineffective. Bridges were blown at SANDRUPT, LAHEYCOURT and BAR LE DUC, and the roads into REVIGNY were mined. There was no enemy front line, and no air, artillery or armor reported.

2) Elements effecting action.

There was no reconnaissance by the enemy, and the civilians seemed to be quite friendly. The terrain was hilly, with rivers running at right angles to the movement of the CT.

2 September 1944

An enemy force estimated at 100 men (SS) in the vicinity of BOUCANVILLE and 100 men in the vicinity of MONTSEC fought delaying action. They had some mortars, but no artillery or other special weapons. This delaying action was unsuccessful, and the enemy withdrew to the East and Northeast.

3 September-7 September 1944

The enemy withdrew in the Regimental Sector to the East bank of the MOSELLE River, and organized there from PAGNY to DIEULOURD with an estimated Division. They were well supplied with artillery of all calibres, with mortars, and with heavy and light machine guns. All bridges over the MOSELLE in the Regimental Zone of Action had been blown. The civilians were not as reliable as they had been previously, and very few of them who had recently been on the East bank of the MOSELLE were to be found. MCUSSON and XON Hills on the East bank of the MOSELLE, and the high ground to the North and South occupied by the Germans afforded them excellent CP's and masks, behind which it was possible to supply and shift troops, and locate Artillery without coming under our observation. In the river valley itself, the ground formed a flat, flood plain over a thousand yards wide, without cover or concealment, giving the Germans excellent fields of fire for their automatic weapons. The river and canal formed a double obstacle to our troops.

8 September-12 September 1944

The Third Panzer Grenadier Division continued to organize on the East bank of the MOSELLE, and German artillery and mortars were active. There were no other changes in the enemy situation during this period.

12 September 1944

German forces from the 29th Regiment, 3d Motorized Division, and the 1121st Regiment of the 553d Division, were captured, and the boundary between these two divisions had passed through the bridge at SCAPORE. The 1121st Regiment had six 81mm mortars, four 120mm mortars, and a number of light and heavy machine guns in each battalion. The 29th Regiment had a similar organization. The 1121st had 18 bazookas (German) per battalion. The attack of the CT 317th on the morning of the 12th September took the defending Germans by surprise, and we had captured our objectives before the

Germans were able to take effective counter measures. The enemy had placed anti-personnel mines in the canal bank in the vicinity of our crossing points, but these were ineffective. German forces withdrew to a line from ATTEN to the Road Junction at (U828321); to MILLERY to the MOSELLE River at (U765180). During the day, German 88 direct fire from MOUSSON and 150mm fire from positions further Northeast harrassed troops and movements in the vicinity of the bridges built by the Engineers, and they attempted unsuccessfully to destroy these bridges. There were very few civilians at the bridgehead. Our forces had excellent observation of the ground to the East from the ST GENEVIEVE-BEZAUMONT ridge, and LA FALAIS hill. Enemy occupation of MOUSSON gave them direct observation of the crossing sites, but the crossing at DIEULGUARD was somewhat screened from enemy observation by trees. We captured 16 PW's.

13 September 1944

The Germans attacked early on the 13th September with 2 Battalions of the 29th Panzer Grenadier Regiment, from FORET DE FACQ, through ST GENEVIEVE and BEZAUMONT, then moved East toward VILLE AU VAL. The attack was supported by artillery and mortar fire, and the Germans also had half-tracks, self-propelled guns and tanks. The Regiment destroyed eight German tanks during the counterattack, which was entirely repulsed by 1400 on the 13th September.

14 September 1944

Early in the morning an enemy AGF unit, consisting of from 400 to 600 men attacked and seized LA FALAIS ridge. By 1700, our counterattack had retaken LA FALAIS, and time fire decimated the enemy AGF unit withdrawing.

15 September 1944

The Enemy, with an estimated force of 1 Battalion, counterattacked in the early morning, and captured ATTEN and ST GENEVIEVE. The attack was supported with tanks, self-propelled guns, artillery and mortar fire. At 1630, an enemy force estimated at 1 Battalion and 33 tanks attacked the ST GENEVIEVE-BEZAUMONT ridge, and were repulsed with the loss of an undetermined number of tanks.

16 September 1944

The enemy occupied the line LANDREMONT-Hill 351-MILLERY with about 2 battalions. They defended successfully at MILLERY and LANDREMONT, supported by artillery and mortars. At about 1700, remnants of the AGF unit which attacked the 3d Battalion on the 14th September, attacked again, but were driven off as darkness fell.

17 September 1944

German forces occupied LANDREMONT-Hill 351-MILLERY. The force on Hill 351 consisted of an outpost and artillery CP, from which effective artillery and mortar fire could be directed on the advance of the 2d Battalion. In MILLERY, a small enemy force occupied the town and directed MG and mortar fire on K Company. There was a small delaying force in LANDREMONT which was strong in automatic weapons. All German forces were forced to withdraw.

REPORT FOR HISTORY SEPTEMBER 1944 - S - 3

1 September 1944

CT continued pursuit of enemy to the East at 0700 with the 1st and 2d Bns abreast, the 1st Bn on the left. CT crossed the Meuse River at Sampigny, 7 kilometers S of St. Mihiel, without opposition. CT continued to advance during day. At 2000 CT was ordered to outpost line St. Mihiel-Montsec-Rambaucourt. 3d Bn passed through 1st and was ordered to OPL. Co G ordered to occupy St. Mihiel.

2 September 1944

3d Bn encountered stiff enemy resistance vicinity Apremont and occupied OPL 1200. 1st and 2d Bns occupied defensive positions Apremont-Liouville.

3 September 1944

CT remained on OPL. Co B ordered to secure trainload of captured enemy material at Essay.

4 September 1944

CT ordered to make reconnaissance in force as far East as Moselle River. 2d Bn moved to vicinity of Thiaucourt at 0700. 1st and 3d Bns continued to East, 1st Bn leading, 3d in reserve. At 2200, CT ordered to cross Moselle River, secure bridgehead vicinity Pont a Mousson and Pagny-sur-Moselle 5 September.

5 September 1944

CT attacked 1000 to secure bridgehead over Moselle River, vicinity Pagny-sur-Moselle and Pont a Mousson. 1st Bn attacked from vicinity Pont a Mousson, 2d Bn from Pagny-sur-Moselle. 3d Bn ordered to attack abreast of 1st Bn afternoon of 5 September. 3d Bn ordered to cross Moselle under cover of darkness night of 5-6 September.

6 September 1944

CT resumed attack to secure bridgehead over Moselle vicinity of Pont a Mousson. All attempts to cross met by strong enemy resistance. Co L affected crossing but enemy counter-attack wiped out bridgehead. 2d Bn withdrew to high ground vicinity Vandieres. 1st and 3d Bns remained vicinity Pont a Mousson.

23 September 1944

CT ordered to attack at 1600 to the East and seize Hill 401 and Hill 418. Attack jumped off at 1645, 3d Bn leading, followed by 2d Bn. Very little progress made. 1st Bn continued to engage enemy in Bois de la Rumont and protected flank of Regiment.

24 September 1944

Attack renewed by 3d Bn at 0700. By 1000 3d Bn had reached objective. 2d Bn reached objective (Hill 418) 1200. 1st Bn ordered to relieve elements 318th Inf on Hill 340.

(1) The enemy strength at Port sur Seille was estimated to be between 60 to 80 men and at Morville between 80 to 100 men. The enemy front lines extends along Cheminot, Morville, Port sur Seille and Benecourt.

(2) Enemy is utilizing commanding ground with the exception of the towns of Port sur Seille and Morville. The enemy is dug in on the west side of Port sur Seille and was using buildings as pillboxes giving line excellent defensive positions. It was reported that the enemy was using the church steeple as an OP and also the Chateau Dombasle. Artillery was used to interdict Atton-Manoncourt Hwy front west of Foret de Facq to a point approximately 500 yards east of the eastern edge of the woods. 10 rounds of artillery fell at Morville. Harrassing fire was maintained throughout the period in various points in this sector.

(3) Three prisoners of war taken.

b. Elements affecting action.

(1) Enemy infiltrated into the towns of Port sur Seille and Morville in strength. The enemy took positions in the school and church at Morville and Port sur Seille. The enemy dug positions on west side of the town under direction of an officer. The enemy resisted all efforts to drive him to the east side of the river. In Morville it was reported by our troops that they were fired on by either enemy in civilian clothes or by civilians with enemy sympathies. Enemy probable knowledge of our situation good.

c. Action.

(1) One Bn of Engrs attached. Otherwise no change.

(2) Mission: To dig in all around defensive position and hold.

CT 319 began improving present positions to make a strong defensive position.

(3) Communication: Wire to all Bns.

(4) 905 FA fired on observed targets.

, Co C 305 Engrs assisted by one Bn of Engrs. Attached to Bns to dig in positions.

(5) Use of bayonets, grenades, flame throwers, etc: none.

(6) Evacuated three Americans and six German dead.

1. St Mihiel, France, on 1 September 1944.
2. Lt Col Elliott B. Cheston, CO 3rd Bn, supervised the attack and capture of St Mihiel and also the high ground surrounding the town.

1. Northwest of Toul, France, on 4 September 1944.
2. Lt Col Elliott B. Cheston, CO 3rd Bn, supervised the capture of the high ground northwest of Toul. The attack commenced at 0700 and after the seizure of the high ground he coordinated a patrol northeast of the Moselle River. 1st Lt Edward B. Leroy, CO of Company I, lead his company across the Moselle River as lead company of the 3rd Bn.

1. Gondreville and Villey le Sec, France, on 5 September 1944.
2. Lt Col Elliott B. Cheston, CO 3rd Bn, organized and supervised the attack on the town of Gondreville and the seizure of Fort Villey le Sec. 1st Lt Leroy, CO of Company I, 1st Lt Smith, CO of Company K, and Capt Mertins, CO of Company L, moved forward abreast of each other. Each company under the guidance of their respective commanding officer advanced slowly and obtained their objective.

1. Liverdun, France, on 8 September 1944.
2. Lt Col Hiram D. Ives, CO of 1st Bn, coordinated the attack on Liverdun. The attack commenced at 0630. At 1500 1st Bn encountered enemy foot troops and armor on the outskirts of Liverdun. At 1830 continued the attack and gained the high ground northwest of Liverdun. Consolidated defensive positions on the high ground overlooking the outskirts of Liverdun.

1. Liverdun, France, on 9 September 1944.
2. Capt James C. Romo, CO of Company A, led the attack in conjunction with Co G of 318 CT at 1830 on Liverdun. Entered the town at 2100 and consolidated positions for the night, preparing plans to mop up the town the next morning. Extensive sniper fire was met upon their entrance into the town of Liverdun.

1. Liverdun, France, on 10 September 1944.
2. Lt Col Hiram D. Ives, CO of 1st Bn, coordinated plans for mopping up the town of Liverdun. Some resistance was encountered but the plans were completed successfully.

1. Pompey, France, on 11 September 1944.


