

## 5. Marches.

The stations listed in paragraph 4, above, are the general locations of the Regimental CP during period. The move from BAR LE DUC to a point 2 miles West of COMMERCY 1 Sep was the only move made during the month of any length, it being a distance of 40 miles. The other moves were comparatively short and were made for the purpose of keeping in close contact with our forward elements. The moves of our forward elements were always forward and were made with one purpose in mind--to close with the enemy and to drive him back.

With the exception of only a few days the weather during this period was wet--rainy and disagreeable for everyone, but particularly so for the men in the fox holes doing the fighting and the supply personnel whose job it was to drive over the muddy, slippery roads at night to resupply them.

## 6. Campaigns.

For the purpose of recording, the activities of CT 8 for the month of September 1944 has been divided into three phases as follows:

- I. "Movement from BAR LE DUC to ROSIERES-EN-HAYE(1-4 Sep 44)
- II. "Battle to clear West Bank of MOSELLE RIVER in Vicinity of the FORET DE L'AVANT GARDE" (5-11 Sep 44)
- III. "Crossing of the MOSELLE RIVER at DIEHLOUARD and Battle of the Bridgehead" (12-30 Sep 44).

The Commanding General, 80th Inf Div was the authority ordering the above named actions.

## 7. Battles.

During the period 1-4 September, inclusive, CT 8 encountered but very little enemy action, due partly to the CT being at that time in Division reserve, but due chiefly to the fact that the enemy had retreated so swiftly as to make it almost impossible to maintain contact. Information gained from PW's taken during this period gave added proof that the enemy had left behind for rearguard actions only small, disorganized and scattered forces from a variety of units; while withdrawing his main forces further East to a point where he could make a determined stand.

Three PW's taken ni : 31 Aug-1 Sep were from 1 29th Regt 3rd Inf Div. Interrogation of these PW's disclosed that at least a part of this Div had only recently arrived in France from the Italian Front and were to have been used for rearguard action, but the swift advance of American forces had compelled their retreat on 30 Aug in a general Easterly direction.


On 1 Sept 1944 CT 8 moved from BAR LE DUC to a point about 3 miles W of COMMERCY. Reconnaissance parties in COMMERCY night 1-2 Sept found a captured freight train carrying a large quantity of German equipment, including ordnance pieces. One platoon was sent to guard this until it could be turned over to the proper authorities

At 0915 2 Sep the CT moved through COMMERCY taking up a defensive positions a few miles NE of the town, still being in Division reserve. The Regtl CP was located just off the highway about 1½ miles NE of the town. While in this position enemy activity in our sector consisted of harassing night patrols, and mines and road blocks put out as a delaying factor by the enemy during their retreat.

On 4 Sept CT 8 moved from vicinity of COMMERCY further to the East preparatory to driving the enemy from the West side of the MOSELLE RIVER. The Reg'l CP was set up in vicinity of ROYAUMEIX.

Phase III- "Battle to clear West Bank of MOSELLE RIVER in vic of the FORET DE L'AVANT GARDE"- (5-11 Sep incl.)

Interrogation of PW's had disclosed that we were faced by elements of the 3rd and 15th Panzer Grenadier Divisions. In addition to these two units PW's were taken from numerous other units, the strength of some as low as 20-30 men, giving further evidence of the disorganization and shortage of manpower existing in the German Army. Other evidence pointing to their manpower shortage was shown in ages of the men being in large numbers of cases, either over or under normal combat age; and their state of training , some having had as little as two weeks basic training.




A reconnaissance patrol, sent forward 4 Sep for the purpose of determining enemy strength and dispositions along the W bank of the MOSELLE, reported enemy defensive positions 3 to 5 kilometers W of the River, numerous enemy patrols active in that area, and enemy artillery located East of the River firing on our positions West of the River.

The enemy situation confronting CT 8 at this time, as compiled from all available sources, put the main enemy forces, consisting of elements of two Infantry Divisions, plus organic arty, occupying commanding ground on E bank of MOSELLE, with delaying forces estimate as at least one Bn. West of River occupying the towns of BELLEVILLE MARBACH and POMPEY, the FORET DE L'AVANT GARDE, and Hills 220 and 326. These delaying forces were identified 5 Sep as 1st Bn 92nd GAF Regiment.

It can be state here that the fighting qualities of these GAF (Ground Air Forces) units was far superior to those of the units mentioned above. Composed of young men, 18-22 years of age, they had joined the German Army under the impression that they would be in the Air Corps and, although disappointed at being used for Infantry fighting instead, it by no means hampered their willingness nor ability to fight. Their morale was as high as that of any unit yet contacted and much higher than that of the average, as evidenced by the comparatively small number of prisoners taken and the stiff resistance put up.

On 4 Sep 44 Commanding General, 80th Infantry Division ordered the 318th to furnish one Bn. to join Combat Command A, 4th Armored Div for future operation in in vic of the MOSELLE RIVER. The 1st Bn. was given this assignment. The Regiment, less one Bn, moved forward 4 September toward the MOSELLE with mission of securing high ground in vic Hill 326 on W bank of MOSELLE on the following day. The mission of taking Hill 326 and Hill 220 was assigned 3rd Bn. at 1526, 6 Sep they succeeded in taking Hill 326. Due to the fierce enemy resistance encountered it was necessary, on 7 Sept 44 committ 2nd Bn, 318th to assist the 3rd Bn in wiping out enemy resistance in this sector.



In view of this resistance, plus additional identifications from PW's it is believed that the entire 92nd GAF Regt, consisting of 3 Bns and company strength of 220 men opposed us at this time.

On 7 Sep 1st Bn was returned to Regimental control for the remainder of this engagement and was held in reserve. At the same time 1st Bn, 319th was attached to the Regiment and was used to protect the exposed right rear of our 2nd Bn until the remainder of 319th could move up abreast of our front on our right flank.


During the night 7-8 Sep the 92nd GAF Regt was relieved by elements of the 553rd Volksgrenadier Div., a unit which had not previously been identified on the Western front. This division was composed of three Inf Regiments (1119th, 11120th, 1121st) one arty regiment, one Fusilier Bn, and one Engr Bn. Each Inf Regt. was composed of two battalions and an Assault Co. of one Machine Pistole platoon and two Engr Platoons. Each Bn. was composed of 3 rifle Cos. and one heavy Wpns, Co.; plus one Inf How Co. per Regt.

The 1553rd Assault Gun Bn, attached to the 553rd Gr Div was committed 7 Sep in POMPEY-MARBACHE sector in support of Gren. units of the 553rd Div. This Bn. was composed of 3 Btrys of five 75 mm assault guns and Mark III chassis each; Bn. had strength of 160 men; each AG crew of four men.

These units had the mission of counterattacking and driving our forces back but were unsuccessful.

Due to poor communications with our forward elements, the Regt'l CP moved forward 8 Sept from vic of ROYAUMEIX to a point in woods approx 1½ miles West of ROSTERES-EN-HAYE.

During the night 8-9 Sept the enemy withdrew the bulk of his forces from the W to the E side of the MOSELLE RIVER, leaving only scattered strong points of resistance to harass and delay our advance. On 9 Sept CT 8 pushed through the FORET DE L'AVANT GARDE, occupying positions on W bank of the MOSELLE RIVER from BELLEVILLE South to LIVERDUN, thus completing the mission of driving the enemy from the W side of the River in its sector.




During this engagement the normal intelligence agencies of the CT were supplemented by the aid of friendly French civilians, most of whom were members of the FFI, who were eager to give information of the enemy. Numerous trips were made by their members through the enemy lines seeking information of immediate tactical importance. Some of their number who never returned from these missions, and later found to have died from enemy action, gave mute evidence of their willingness to serve in the cause of the liberation of France.

(The terrain over which this action took place, as could well be expected, offered excellent opportunities for defense. Until forced to retreat entirely from the West side of the River, the enemy at all times held commanding ground from which to view our movements. (The dense undergrowth of the FORET DE L'AVANT GARDE, which permitted visibility of only a few yards, added to the hazards and difficulties of the attacking force.)

A total of 87 PWs was taken during this action, as against 217 casualties suffered by the Regt from the beginning of Sep. Of these 125 were wounded, 49 killed and 43 missing. Among those killed was the 3rd Bn Commander, Lt Col John B. Snowden III, wounded by a sniper's bullet late in the afternoon 7 Sep and died at 0300 the following morning as a result of it. He was succeeded at the time by Major George W. Connaughton, 3rd Bn Executive Off., who was, a few days later, replaced by Major Earl Nuessner.

In this, as in all previous actions, the Regiment was closely and adequately supported by its supply section, by whom no effort was spared in the job of keeping the supplies and equipment available to those who needed them when they needed them.

Col. Harry D. McHugh was the CT Commander during this engagement.

Phase III (12-30 Sep incl)  
"Crossing of the MOSELLE RIVER at DIEULOURD and Battle of the Bridgehead"


Higher headquarters had decided that CT 7 occupying positions on West bank of the MOSELLE directly North of us, would force a river crossing at DIEULOURD 12 September and secure a bridgehead on the opposite side. Immediately after this accomplishment, CT 8 (less 1st Bn which had been attached to US 4th Armd Div) was to utilize the crossing made by CT 7 and push to the South and East, CT 7 in the meantime with the mission of pushing to the North.

FW reports at this time indicated that the ground East of the MOSELLE from NANCY North to BEZAUMONT was defended by the 553rd Gr Div, with the 1121st Gr Regt on the North flank, BEZAMOUNT being the boundary line between the 553rd South and 3rd Pz Gr Div on the North, the 29th Pz Gr Regt of this unit being on the Div South flank.

It was believed that the enemy had scattered his forces thinly. bit with considerable automatic weapons supplemented by mines and booby traps, at all strategic points along the River line, while holding his main forces in mobile reserve some distance behind this line; thus enabling him to utilize the maximum of his defensive powers to repel our crossing at whatever point we might attempt it. If such was the enemy's plan however, the latter part of it, at least, failed to work out.

CT 7 began its attack at 0400 12 Sep and encountered heavy automatic fire, supported by artillery and mortar fire from concealed positions East of the River. CT 7 effected a crossing in record time meeting considerably less resistance than had been anticipated, with the result that CT 8 (-) began moving to DIEULOURD at 0730 to cross behind them. The bridge remained under constant artillery and mortar fire throughout the day and night, but CT 8 units encountered no small arms nor automatic fire while crossing.

During the afternoon and evening of 12 Sep 44 318th (-) crossed to East side of the River. The Regimental CP closed into location on E bank at 2130. 2nd Bn, 318th occupied road blocks vic of BEZAUMONT. 3rd Bn. occupied assigned area in rear of 2nd Bn. Co. F manned road block vicinity LOISY; Co I manned road block vicinity LE PON DU MONS;



Co I manned road block vic :E PON DU MONS; Co K manned road block vic VILLE AU VAL.

During early hours of 13 Sep enemy infantry, supportedly by tanks and artillery , launched a counterattack on the bridgehead, After br-eaking through 317th Inf and CP of 2nd Bn 318th Infantry, they overran Regt'l CP, 318th. By daybreak the enemy had been thrown back as far as BEZAUMONT. During this battle the Regt'l CP suffered several casual-ties among the staff. Wounded included the Regt'l Commander, Col. Harry D. McHugh; Ret'l S-3 ,Capt Howard C. Johnson; Ret'l Communications Off-icer, 1st Lt Harry E Sadler, who later died of wounds; I and R platoon leader, 2nd Lt Joseph L, Murphy; Asst Communications Officer WOJG Richard P Dodd. The Regt'l Executive Officer Lt. Col Roy J. Herte, and S-1 Capt Louis R Pickering , were captured. Lt. Col John C. C. Golden 2nd Bn Commander, assumed command of the Regiment and retook the ground gained by the enemy during the counterattack.


According to information from PW's taken 13 Sep the enemy attack of that morning had been made by the 29th Pz Gr Regt (with the probable exception of 2 Cos.), plus the 4th Co., 103 Assault Gun Bn; and 2nd Co. 3rd AT Bn ; all from 3rd Pz Gr Div. Their mission had been to attack from the vic of FORET DE FACC and reoccupy the high ground East of the MOSELLE.

The average strength of companies in the 29th Pz Gr Regt was 40-50 men, although some were up to strength of 80 men. Most of the companies had 5-7 LMG's and 2 HMG's; 4th, 8th and 11th Cos. had four 80 mm mortars and four 120 mm mortars each.

4th Co, 103rd AG Bn committed in counterattack of 0300 13 Sep was equipped with bazookas, grenade launchers, AT rifles and 2 LMG's. 1st,2nd, and 3rd Cos of this Bn were equipped with 75 mm assault guns (SP on Mark IV chassis).

2nd Co, 3rd AT Bn was equipped with fourteen 75 mm AT guns(SB) on Mark IV chassis, ten of which were used in counterattack of 130300.

3rd Arty Regt 3rd Pz Gr Div was composed of 3 Bns 1st and 2nd with 12 150 mm Field How.



On the morning of 13 Sep, after the enemy counterattack had been driven back, the Regt'1 CP moved to a concrete cellar in LE PON DU MONS. Capt Frank Williams, Co F, 318th, with approximately 20 men, attacked and captured BEZAUMONT, taking 87 prisoners. 2nd Bn occupied BEZAUMONT, patrolled to the South, Southeast and East and set up a road block vic of LANDREMONT and another 1½ kilometers East of VILLE-AU-VAL. 3rd Bn, 318th took LOISY and patrolled North, Northeast and East, and maintained road blocks in its sector. Contact was established with CT 7 on our right flank. The road block on our South flank was moved from a point 600 yds South of LE PON DU MONS to AUTREVILLE, captured by one platoon of tanks; attachments to 3rd Bn were one platoon towed tank destroyers, six tanks one platoon Regt'1 AT guns. Regimental AT Co, less one platoon, was given mission of protecting Regt'1 CP. Cannon Co. remained in firing position vic. Regt'1 CP in general support. Two tanks were held in Regt'1 reserve.

Late in the afternoon 13 Sep, Col M.C. Shattuck assumed command of the 318th. During the reorganization of Regt which followed, Lt Col Clarence W. Docka, newly assigned to the Regiment was assigned to 2nd Bn as CO; and Lt Col John C. Golden was assigned as Regt'l Exec. Officer.

at 0900 on 14 Sep 3rd Bn (reinforced) launched an attack to the North with mission of taking MOUSON HILL. The town of ATTEN was taken and MOUSSON HILL occupied by 141304 Sep. An enemy counterattack made the following morning retook ATTEN and adjacent terrain, isolating our 3rd Bn, two platoons Regt'1 AT Co and one platoon medium tanks, one platoon towed tank destroyers, and the 81mm mortar platoon of Co H on MOUSSON HILL. From ATTEN the enemy attack turned South towards LOISY. Since there was no Regt'1 reserve, Cannon Co. placed its guns for laying direct fire on the advancing Germans. Men of Hq. Co. 3rd Bn who had not yet moved to MOUSSON HILL, and the 105 mm howitzers of Cannon Company laying direct fire on the enemy from vic of LOISY halted the counterattack. 1st platoon, Co B, 305th Engr was ordered to LOISY to assist in holding that town. At 1600 15 Sep while all available troops of the CT were engaged in repelling enemy counterattacks from the North, Northeast, and East, another counter-



attack was formed on our South flank vic of MOISY and BELLEAU by elements of 1119th and 1121st Gren Regts 553rd Gren Div ; 92nd GAR Regt (recently attached to 553rd Gren Div by General Order) of 1553rd Arty Regt. This counterattack was stopped by our artillery before the enemy made contact with our troops.

At 1245,15 Sep G-3 notified the Regt'l CO that our 1st Bn at Command A, 4th Armored Div at ARRACOURT , one Co of tanks attached for the duration of its back to the Regiment. It was necessary for the Bn to fight its way through CHAMBREY, FRESNES-EN-SAULNOIS, LEMONCOURT, AULNOIS-SUR-SEILLE and on to the regt in vic of ST GENEVIEVE and LE PON DU MONS. Bn kitchen train and one platoon of Cpl C guarding approximately 1000 prisoners of war taken during operation with CCA were sent by a safer route via NANCY and thence to LE PON DU MONS.

Radio contact was established with the Bn enroute and orders were issued for any attack on ST GENEVIEVE from the East as soon as possible. This attack was launched at 0900 16 Sep and the village of ST. GENEVIEVE was occupied at 1050.

The Div CO , 80th Inf Div laid plans for 1st Bn 319th and 1st Bn 318th to launch a coordinated attack from vic of LOISY and relieve 3rd Bn 318th on MOUSSON HILL on 16 Sep. Two circumstances upset this plan. First, it was necessary for 1st Bn., 318th to be resupplied after making its return trip from the East and taking ST GENEVIEVE before it could continue its attack to assist in relieving the 3rd Bn. This Bn had made record time in the face of heavy enemy resistance in accomplishing its mission of returning to the Regt and attacking ST. GENEVIEVE as soon as possible. The second circumstance that hindered a coordinated attack by the two Bns was a German counterattack directed toward LOISY where 1st Bn 319th was located, just prior to the hour set by the Commanding General for that Bn to attack without immediate aid from 1st Bn 318th. This enemy attack was repulsed, however, and 1st Bn 319th continued on to ATTON meeting little resistance. There enemy in some strength was encountered and progress was slowed down. By 1900 contact was established with 3rd Bn 318th on MOUSSON HILL and by 2040 evacuated of wounded from the Hill had begun.

1st Bn 319th continued on to secure the high ground NE of MOUSSON HILL. Every day that our 3rd Bn was isolated on MOUSSON HILL rations, blood plasma, and ammunition were flown into them by means of arty liason planes. When 1st Bn, 319th launched its attack on 16 Sep to contact them, ambulance vehicles filled with rations, water, ammunition were held in readiness to move up to MOUSSON HILL as soon as the road was cleared from them to beach the Bn. These supplies, as well as the ambulances for evacuation of the wounded were moved up shortly after 2000 on the 16th. Casualties among personnel of the 3rd Bn during its isolation were exceedingly light, considering that it had been subjected to constant arty and mortar fire in addition to numerous counterattacks and attempted infiltrations on the Bn defensiv e positions on the Hill. Among those killed by snipers was Brigadier General Searby, Div Arty Commander, who was with the Bn near the highest point on the Hill in an obsn post.


At 1815 on the 16th , 1st Bn 318th completed its resupply and moved out to the North with mission of flushing all enemy elements from FORET DE FACQ, thence to the Northeast to capture and occupy MORVILLE-SUR-SEILLE. By 170645 Sep the Bn was moving through FORET DE FACQ and at 0800 had taken MORVILLE-SUR-SEILLE . It then began consolidating its positions to ward off a possible counterattack. After dark the next evening the Bn was relieved by units of 319th Inf had returned to Regt'l reserve in LOISY . In the meantime, Co F and one platoon Co E were ordered to ATTEN to outpost the town until relieved by 319th Inf. Co. G relieved a Company of 319th in ST. GENE<sup>V</sup>E VIEVE. The remainder of 2nd Bn moved to BEZAUMONT occupying high ground to the Northeast.

Late on the afternoon 17 Sep 3rd Bn 318th moved to BEZAUMONT where it took up defensive positions.

On 18th Sept and 19th Sept the Regt cleared the woods to our North-east BOIS DE BUZARD and BOIS DE MANCHE, of the enemy and 21 Sep turned to the South and Southeast , taking Hill 340, MOREY, pushed through the BOIS DE LA RUMONT and BRATTE on 23 Sept.

The Regtl CP moved to MILLERY 22 Sep closing at 1720.

From BRATTE our attack turned to the Northeast for the purpose of driving the enemy from his high ground on Hill 407 MT TOULON



and MT. ST JEAN. Regts of the 1119th and 112<sup>t</sup> Gr Regts 553rd Gren Div were fighting stubbornly to hold this high ground, with the 1110th responsible for MT TOULON and the 1121st responsible for MT ST JEAN.

On Sep 24 the Regt CP moved to BRATTE completing the move at 1200.

26 Sep 44 Col Lansing McVickar assumed command of the Regt.

During the night 26-27 Sep our 2nd and 3rd Bns were relieved by elements of 317th Inf, and then protected 3rd Bn 317 from a possible enemy counterattack from direction of MOIVRON and SIVRY. During this period 1st Bn 318th was held in Div reserve.

On Sep 27 the 318th went into Div reserve. The Regt CP was moved to VILLE-AU-VALLE.

The last three days of Sep were spent in organizing defensive positions.

During the month of Sep the Regt gained invaluable battle experience from probably fiercest battles it had been engaged in since arriving in the ETO. Members of the Regt could point with pride to the part our men played in forcing and holding the largest and one of the first bridgeheads across the MOSELLE. The XII Corps Commander Maj Gen Manton B Eddy repeatedly during his visits to the Regt CP at LE PON DU MONS commended the Regt for its stand on the Eastybanks of the River under trying circumstances. He stated that the tenacity of our stand drew enemy forces opposing us in such large numbers that several bridgeheads at other points along the River were possible because of the light enemy resistance.

During the period 12-30 Sep 44 the Regt captured 532 PW's, 4 of which were officers; an additional 10 PW's were evacuated through medical channels and 103 enemy dead were buried. Total: 631 PW's captured in Sep 44.

The Regt lost 821 821 casualties during this period with 539 wounded, 139 killed, and 143 missing; thus bringing our total casualties for Sep 44 up to 1038. Of these 644 were wounded, 188 killed and 186 missing in action.

Regt COs during this period were Col Harry D. McHugh 12-130500 Lt. Col John H. Golden 130800-131900; Col H.C. Shattuck 131900-26; Col Lansing McVickar 26-30.
